 Day of February one thousand seven hundred and Eighty three Lying and being
 in the County of Montgomery on a Branch of new River and Bounded as followeth
 To wit, Beginning at Two white Oaks and a Black Oak Corner to Allfords
 Lands and with the same South ten degrees East fifty six poles to three white oak
 Saplings South Sixty degrees West Sixty six poles To two White Oaks on a hill side South
 Twenty degrees West thirty Poles to a white Oak and South South ten degrees West
 one hundred and Twenty poles to two white Oaks thence leaving said Pine East
 Eighty six Poles to two Black Oaks on the Top of a hill, North Sixty five degrees
 East one hundred and forty poles to two white Oaks on the Top of a hill North fifty
 six Poles Crossing a Branch to Two Black Oaks and a white Oak Sapling North
 thirty degrees West one hundred and thirty five poles to two white Oaks North
 Sixty degrees West forty poles to three Black oak Saplings South Sixty degrees
 West forty poles to the Beginning with its appurtenances; To have and to hold the
 said Tract or Parcel of Land with its appurtenances, To the said William Ad erold and
 his heirs for ever. In Witness whereof the said Benjamin Harrison Esquire Governor
 of the Commonwealth of Virginia, hath hereunto set his Hand, and caused the Sealer seal
 of the said Commonwealth To be affixed at Richmonds, on the tenth day of July in the year of
