Wm. Hanell & Will In the name of God I William Hanell of Wythe County and State of Virginia being Weak in body but of a perfect sound and disposing mind and memory and calling to mind the uncertainty of life and certainty of death do make and declare this to be my last Will and Testament in manner and form following to wit in the first place I recommend my soul to god who gave it & my body to the earth to be buried in in a decent manner as to such worldly estate as it hath please god to bless me with I give and dispose of the same in following manner. first I direct my just debts to be paid and a fund for that purpose I direct twenty Dollars to be paid to Martha Hanell my wife for annuity during her life time and if that is not sufficient the Boys John Hanell and Reuben Hanell is to pay a sufficiency to keep her her lifetime and if they will not do it it is to be taken out of the land with all my household furniture farming tools with all my stock of cattle and sheep and the house I now live in during her life and at her death this property is to be equally divided between John Hanell and Reuben Hanell The tract of land he now lives on as follows beginning at a large live on the track of I now live on thence crossing the

the branch up the hill to a black oak and a hickory sapling
thence crossing the hollow to the top of the ridge to two black oaks
and two chestnut oaks thence straight on till it intersects With
John Christy line thence on a South West course on his line to
the pine tree thence along his line the several corners and corners
to Sampson land from thence it runs With Sampson line and
corners to Peter Thrasher land thence running With Thrasher line &
corners to Crockett's land thence crossing the branch to Floreys
corners thence With Floreys line thence along Floreys line to the
corner of the land & now live on thence along the line to the
beginning - the said John Harrell and Ruben Harrell is to
pay the heirs fifty dollars each to Wit William Harrell Elizabeth
Spence Sarah Smith twenty five dollars each I give & bequeath to
my son Ruben Harrell all the Rest of the land that is the tract
I now live on and the balance of the tract of land I bought of
Capt. Tind and I give to him a small survey of twelve acres
I give to my son Ruben Harrell a large family Bible I give
and bequeath to my little grand son Morrow Harrell Jacob
Harrell sons of Jacob Harrell deceased ten dollars each and to
my daughter Mary Patrick or her legal heirs one dollar and to
my daughter Nancy Brown or her legal heirs one dollar and to
my daughter Rebecca Aaley or her legal heirs one dollar - And
I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint my son John Harrell
and Ruben Harrell both of Wilkes County my Executor of this
my last Will and Testament by me made and do declare
all other Wills and Voide and this only to be my last Will &
Testament in Witness Whereof I have hereunto subscribed my
name and affixed my seal this twentieth day of April
in year of our lord One thousand Eight hundred & twenty two

scribing Witnesses thereto and the same is Ordered to be Recorded
And at a Court held for said County the 10th day of September
1822 On the motion of John Harrell One of the Executors named
in said Will Who entered into Bond With John Christy his Surety
(Who justified as to his sufficiency) in the sum of Three hundred
Dollars Condition as the Law directs Hook the Oath required
by Law Probate of the said Will is granted him in due form
